<b>*State Assessments</b>	0.0	Completion of the State of Michigan required assessments, as administered during high school.
<b>Middle School Students – High School Classes</b>	N/A	Credit bearing high school courses taken prior to high school matriculation will appear on a student’s Troy School District high school transcript including the grades earned for the course. High school courses may be retaken for any reason prior to or concurrent with the next course in sequence. Retaken course grade shall replace initial course grade unless prior administrative approval is granted.
<b>Total Credits needed for Graduation</b>	22.5	All students are required to earn a total of 22.5 credits to be eligible for Troy High School or Troy Athens Diploma.
